CREDIT COURSES SEMESTER 2

- Tuesdays and Thursdays from February 14 - June 8, 2017 from 6:00 - 9:00 pm. **(FULL AND REPEAT CREDIT)**
- **Please note there is no school: March 13 – 17, 2017 (March Break), April 6, 2017 (parent/teacher interviews - day school), or April 13, 2017 at night only (Holy Thursday),**

ELIGIBILITY

- Current Secondary school students may register if the student obtains a signed permission form from his/her day school Principal/Principal's designate. Adult Students can register with a copy of their high school transcript. (see below "How to Register").

ATTENDANCE

- Prompt attendance for each scheduled class is expected. Three absences in a full credit or repeat course and one and a half absences in a half credit course, will result in withdrawal from the program. Three lates classify as one absence.

FEES

- A **\$100.00 (cheque only) book deposit** made payable to **St. Charles** is required on the first day of class for most credit courses. The cheque will be returned when the student returns the book.
- Students that damage or vandalise school property will be held responsible for any and all costs associated with their actions.
- **Foreign Visa Students: Full credit course - \$1050.00; Half credit course - \$525.00** (cash or certified cheque only), is payable in full at time of registration. Refunds only if we cancel the class.

HOW TO REGISTER

REGISTER IN ONE OF TWO WAYS:

- 1) **ON-LINE REGISTRATION:** Begins September 6, 2016 for Semester 1, or January 9, 2017 for Semester 2 at <http://coned.hwcdsb.ca>. **Log in** if you have an account (NOT the same as your school login) or **create** a new account (BE ACCURATE). Bring your signed permission form with you to the first class (Download this from stcharles.ca). Adult students must also bring their high school transcript to register for Credit classes.
- 2) **ON-SITE REGISTRATION:** Only if you have NOT registered on-line, you can register at the Night School location of your choice from 6:00 to 8:00 pm on September 15, 2016 for Semester 1, and February 9, 2017 for Semester 2. You **MUST** have your signed permission form to register (Download this from stcharles.ca). Adult students must also bring their high school transcript to register for Credit classes.

PLEASE NOTE - REPORT CARDS are mailed to the day school you have indicated, make sure this information is correct.

Adult and Public board students must bring their high school transcript, photo identification, and Immigration status (if born outside of Canada) to register for Credit classes.

DRESS CODE

- Clothing suitable for a school setting at the discretion of the Principal.
